For this project I used GSAP to bring a stickman with his bag of tricks to life. User interaction reveals tech icons representing core technologies I have experience with. Further interactions trigger text to appear and animate showing experience (measured in time) relevant to each technology. This project threw up a range of interesting challenges, from cross browser compatibility issues, to the organisation of complex animation and SVG.

Netflix Scroller

A React application to emulate Netflix's content scroller

In this project I got to know the TMDB Api. Foreseeing a potential issue, I created a cache to prevent additional fetches should a given item appear in more than one list. To handle complexity, I switched from vanilla JS to GSAP for the animations. The result: a slider whose look and feel conform nicely to that of Netflix's slider.

Facebook Clone

A React application to mimic the Facebook UI

This project was an exercise in the reactive way of doing things, using React Hooks, Styled Components and React Router, resulting in home and profile pages, featuring active navigation, modals, animated and emojis, as employed on facebook's own site. It also required innovative solutions to layout challenges, and subtitles in the 'Like' button's behaviour.
